Having a portrait painted is a special event in one's life. Artist Bentley Brooks uses the finest oil paints and materials in creating highly detailed, realistic portraits that capture the essence and personality of each subject. The portrait-painting process begins with an initial consultation with the client to determine the size, setting, design and pose for the portrait.

The artist prefers to rely on photographs exclusively. The next step involves a photo session in which the artist photographs the client in a variety of poses and lighting combinations to achieve the desired effect. Normally, about one hour is required to photograph the subject and can be done on location. The artist and the client will then select the photo and background from which the portrait will be based. Portraits typically take 2-4 months to complete, depending on complexity. Delivery will be arranged upon completion.

A deposit of 25% is due in advance, with balance due at completion of commission. Major credit cards accepted.



Additional Costs:

Add 80% of the base cost more for each additional person in a portrait. An additional fee may be added depending on the complexity of the portrait. All portraits are delivered unframed and do not include framing costs. Prices do not include any sales tax that may apply. Any shipping costs, including crating and insurance, are additional.

To produce a giclée an additional \$75 fee will be charged for the required high resolution imaging of the portrait. A giclée is a state-of-the-art replication of a painting produced on a high-quality digital printer. Giclées are virtually indistinguishable from the original painting.
